



Main hunting programs — 2018

General terms and conditions:

Title of programs:

Each program heading indicates main trophy and its hunting region. All other possible trophies are included in the section “Additional/Supplementary Trophies”.

Hunting period:

Dates stated in the programs are connected with officially permitted dates of hunting, as well as weather and other conditions. An anticipated change of hunting dates, as per a hunter's request, shall be discussed well in advance.

Number of hunters in a group:

A number of hunters in a group is indicated on all the programs and implies a number of hunters the given price is calculated for. It also implies hunting in only one area (camp) without division into sub-groups.

In some cases hunters may be combined in large groups, in which they can travel together to a place of a hunt. During hunting most likely they will be separated for the sake of successful hunt and quality of service.

In case a hunter comes alone, each program indicates a special charge for a lone hunter.

Accommodations:

In our programs we shortly indicate conditions of accommodations for each hunt. If a hunter has specific questions we will answer them on a case-by-case basis. In many regions we can organize hunts in several areas where conditions of accommodations are different. We are always trying to provide the best possible comfort in places of hunt, but conditions may vary from program to program.

Duration of program:

Duration of each trip is defined taking into account specifics of transport and its schedule, as well as hunting features of the region. Number of hunting days is planned to provide enough time to get a good size trophy. If, for any reason, a hunter leaves a camp earlier than it is foreseen by the program, a refund for unused days of service will not be available.

Prices:

All prices indicated in the programs are valid for 2018 season.

All prices listed in the hunting programs are NET PRICES of *National Hunting Service* only. These are the values, which *National Hunting Service* expects to collect for each respective hunt. These prices are not disclosed to your hunters. You are authorized to add up any amount of your commission to these prices and publish your quotations in catalogs and other promotional materials. In all negotiations with your hunters that we might have, we will always use your quotations. Should there be a situation when you want *National Hunting Service* to collect from hunters any additional payments with your commission included, we may certainly do it for you and later on we will agree on mutual settlements.

Although it is unlikely, we reserve the right to revise our prices quoted in US Dollars due to dramatic fluctuation of exchange rates for major currencies or critically increased costs from our local partners and suppliers.

Our package of services includes the following:

- Visa support documents;
- Preparation of all documents for import and export of hunting firearm(s) and ammunition;
- Organization of all meetings and departures at airports;
- Hotel accommodations (*only where it's stipulated by relevant hunting program*);
- Assistance in hotels booking;
- Transportation in cities;
- Driver-guide and interpreter services in Moscow and other major cities;
- Ticket reservation for domestic flights according to a program;
- Interpreter at camp (one for a group) – *might not be available in every region*;
- 2–3-times a day meal on the camp(s);
- Alcohol drinks in reasonable amounts;
- At least one guide per hunter;
- Transportation at camps according to a program;
- Hunting licenses and all other documents and certificates related to a particular hunt;
- Basic treatment and packing of trophies*
- Registrations of export documents for trophies*
- Deferred shipping of trophies, including enhanced trophy treatment and storage*

Some services might be already included in the service fee or available as extras. For details, please refer to a particular Program and the program-related "Table of extra expenses".

Observers:

An observer is an accompanying person to anyone in a group of hunters. The status of “observer” does not provide individual servicing by a way of transportations, guiding, etc.

Additional/Supplementary trophies:

In this section of each program all animals that can be hunted at the same camp are listed. Additional payments for service in these cases are not charged. Chances of getting an additional trophy vary, but places for camps are chosen only with a consideration of a goal to extract the main trophy (which is indicated in a program heading).

(*) Exportation of trophies:

In most countries where our hunting programs are operated, local regulations for international export of trophies tend to reinforce State control for all sorts of paperwork. As a result, lengthy post-hunting trophy formalities make almost impossible for any foreign hunter to take trophies home on the plane. This situation has already existed for many years in Central Asia and now Russia follows the way. In all these countries we have reliable partners, proven to render quality services in taxidermy, storage and shipping of trophies. Wherever there is a chance that hunters would need to leave their trophies in the country, our relevant Tables of Extra Expenses always show quite close estimates for all procedures and costs related to the process of deferred trophy shipping.

In Central Asia these costs will be invoiced by our local partners and shall be paid to them in full before the shipment is released.

For hunts in Russia, the general guideline and action plan will be as follows:

- **NHS** provides enhanced trophy treatment, short-term storage, packing, local transportation and domestic shipment from a hunting area to our international shipping partner company in Moscow. This domestic trophy care package is charged directly by NHS with a flat per-trophy fee stipulated in relevant Table of Extra Expenses.
- Once trophies are in Moscow in possession of our international shipping partner company “*Trophy Rus Consult*”, their manager get in direct contact with hunters, collecting updated shipping instructions, processing international export paperwork and invoicing hunters directly before the shipment occurs.
