Please be aware that further to newly introduced Russian State Trophy Export Regulations, all trophies will have to be shipped to their respective owners with some delay, required for extended post-hunting paperwork processing. All harvested trophies will be duly treated for long-term storage and forwarded to our partner professional trophy shipping company in Moscow. The company will store the trophies at their own specially equipped premises until all export documentation is ready and will ship them according to hunter's instructions.
